Noble Earth Technologies 'Fog Free' is ideal for glass, mirrors and plastics in architectural applications, marine vessels and motor vehicles. Also suitable for safety goggles, welding masks, swimming goggles and diving masks. Noble Earth Technologies 'Fog Free' prevents the development of fog increasing visibility and safety.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** In order to achieve the best results follow instructions exactly. Do NOT use an absorbent cloth, such as micro-fibre, to apply or buff Noble Earth Technologies 'Fog Free' as this will remove the treatment. SHAKE CAN WELL BEFORE USE.

Apply Noble Earth Technologies 'Fog Free' to the surface using a non-absorbent cloth. Buff the surface until the surface is clear of any product residue. The treated surface will now be resistant to the development of fog. This treatment is removed by water and/or chemical cleaners, therefore, repeat the process when necessary or after each cleaning operation. Excess product on the surface, in the form of a residue, is not to be removed by any other cleaning process but buffed or worked into the surface.

**SAFETY DIRECTIONS:** Highly Flammable. Do NOT spray near fire or open flame. Do NOT puncture or incinerate. Avoid prolonged exposure to sunlight. Do NOT store at temperatures over 50°C. Use with adequate ventilation. Avoid prolonged breathing of vapour or repeated contact with skin.

**FIRST AID:** If poisoning occurs, contact a Poisons Information Centre (phone 13 11 26 from anywhere in Australia) or a doctor. If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly. If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water. If in eyes, hold eyes open and flood with water for at least 15 minutes and then see a doctor.
