Noble Earth Technologies 'Invisible Solvent Guard' is not a coating, but rather a formulation that chemically reacts with the silica capillaries of the substrate and becomes an integral part of the substrate it is protecting. Noble Earth Technologies 'Invisible Solvent Guard' is ideal for marble, granite, tiles and all dense masonry.

Noble Earth Technologies 'Invisible Solvent Guard' protects the surfaces from staining and soiling. It also allows for the easy removal of chewing gum from any surface that has been treated. Noble Earth Technologies 'Invisible Solvent Guard' is a unique product, as it allows the substrate to breath, yet prevents the leaching of salts from behind the treated surfaces. As Noble Earth Technologies 'Invisible Solvent Guard' is not a coating, it does not detract from the non-slip properties of surfaces or alter the natural appearance of the treated surface.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Clean the surface thoroughly with a Noble Earth Technologies degreaser (please see your Noble Earth Technologies representative for advice) and/or an acidic wash, such as Noble Earth Technologies 'Stone and Concrete Wash' if necessary. Ensure that the surface is dust and oil free. The surface must be completely dry and free of all moisture prior to the application. Apply Noble Earth Technologies 'Invisible Solvent Guard' to the surface by roller, brush or low pressure sprayer. We recommend spraying. Two passes are required and the second application should be done while the first application is wet. Avoid windy conditions when spraying as this may reduce the application rate.

Coverage is approximately 6 to 8 square metres per litre.
