Noble Earth Technologies 'Timber Care' is a marine grade, water resistant, deep penetrating clear timber treatment. It is ideal for all natural timbers, especially suited for application to Teak (used in marine environments). The coating bonds and penetrates the fibres of the timber to form a tough protective water resistant barrier, thus, reducing cracking and UV degradation.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Prior to application, ensure the surface is dry and free of dirt, oil and any other contaminants. If the surface has an existing coating or varnish, this should be stripped and sanded back to the bare timber. After the surface is prepared, apply Noble Earth Technologies 'Timber Care' using a lambs' wool floor applicator, or roller, and saturate the surface with the product and allow it to soak in for 10-20 minutes. Then using a clean cotton rag or lambs' wool applicator, wipe over the area to ensure that the product has completely penetrated the timber. Allowing at least 12 hours between applications, apply up to 3 treatments, sanding lightly in between the second and third application.

NOTE: One application is sufficient; however, the additional applications will build on the first, providing deeper colour and longer-lasting protection. Depending on the timber, additional treatments may also produce a gloss finish.

Thinning – Noble Earth Technologies 'Timber Care' is supplied ready to use, however, for the first treatment only, the product can be thinned if necessary with up to 10% mineral turps.

Dry time – The treatment will be touch dry within approximately one hour. Do NOT apply if the temperature is below 12°C. The complete curing process will take approximately 3 days; during this period avoid unnecessary use of the area.

Coverage – Approximately 8m² (or 3 passes) depending on the porosity and texture of the timber.

Clean up – Wash brushes and equipment with mineral turps. Soak all used clothes and sanding dust in water, as they may self-ignite.
